CCC enjoyed an exciting VBS and Easter Egg Hunt. Both had great volunteer support, and encouraging member and visitor turnout.

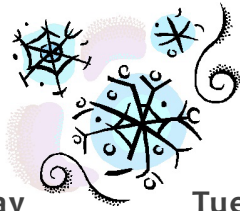
